ROCK EAGLE, EATONTON, GA

SERVICE PROJECT INFORMATION:

The **GILC** conference will commence with an outdoor service project at the Oliver N. Worley Environmental Education Center in Eatonton from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm, February 19th, 2016. The Worley Center is a nonprofit educational outdoor facility managed by Lockerly Arboretum in Milledgeville.

Greg Eilers, Educational Programs Coordinator at Lockerly, and his staff will be coordinating several projects, such as trail maintenance and mulch planting. Students should wear comfortable, casual, outdoor clothing that can get dirty. If the weather is cold on the day of the service project, students should be prepared with plenty of layers, and a hat and gloves to stay warm. If it rains heavily on February 19, we will need to cancel the project since it is completely outdoors, but we will keep our fingers crossed for good weather! Directions to the Service Project

The Worley Center is located in Eatonton, just south of Rock Eagle off Highway 441. The address is 239 Parks Rd SE, Eatonton, GA 31024.

From Rock Eagle:

Head south on Highway 441. Once you reach the (Gray Highway) GA 129 intersection (Wal-Mart and BP) continue to travel approximately 1 mile south on highway 441 toward Milledgeville. You will be turning left onto old Milledgeville

Road (there is a turning lane.) Travel about ¼ mile, immediately after you cross the Railroad tracks you will be turning left onto Park Road.

Travel 0.8 miles down Park Road. After you pass an area where power lines cross the road, slow down and turn left at the next drive. The Driveway is easy to miss, but it does have a stop sign. You will see a green house from the Road that is a part of the Worley Center. If you reach the bridge, you just missed it.

Once you arrive, you will continue down the Gravel drive past a pond and then you will find the parking area. It is over ½ mile to the parking area.

From the South:

Head north on Highway 441. When you are almost to Eatonton you will come to a large new bridge that crosses a road. Just after the overpass you will be turning right onto old Milledgeville Road. Travel about ¼ mile, immediately after you cross the Railroad tracks you will be turning left onto Park Road.

Travel 0.8 miles down Park Road. After you pass an area where power lines cross the road, slow down and turn left at the next drive. The Driveway is easy to miss, but it does have a stop sign. You will see a green house from the Road that is a part of the Worley Center. If you reach the bridge, you just missed it.

Once you arrive, you will continue down the Gravel drive past a pond and then you will find the parking area. It is over ½ mile to the parking area.
